

RULES & REGULATIONS

2009 CLASS A PIMP MY HUMMER LOTTERY RULES

- 1. ELIGIBILITY** - The Lottery is open to the public but not those associated directly with the Lottery. Tickets may be sold and purchased only in British Columbia.
- 2. HOW TO ENTER** - Print your name, address, telephone number and email address on the tickets and deposit in the safety boxes on site before 12pm on December 23rd, 2009. All tickets will be eligible for the draw if purchased by deadline. The draw is held at Last Door Recovery Society (323 8th Street, New Westminster, V3M 3R3) the prize is drawn manually from a barrel.
- 3. PRIZES SHALL CONSIST OF** - 1 Grand Prize Package a Custom 1996 H1 Hummer
- 4. LICENCE** - The Pimp My Hummer Raffle is licensed by the Province of British Columbia. BC Gaming Event License #17629. The Lottery licence covers the period from August 29, 2009 to December 23rd, 2009.
- 5. PRIZES NON-REFUNDABLE** - The Lottery prize must be accepted as awarded and has no cash equivalent and is not transferable or refundable. Costs incurred in picking up the prize awarded are borne by the winner.
- 6. ENTRIES** - All entries become the property of Last Door and no entries will be returned.
- 8. PUBLICITY** - In entering the Lottery, each entrant acknowledges the right of Last Door, in the event that the entrant is declared a winner, to publish and broadcast the entrant's name, address, photograph, and voice statements in any publicity carried out by Last Door, at its sole discretion without charge of or compensation to any such entrant. Winners consent to the release of their names by the licensee.
- 9. RELEASE** - As a condition of and in consideration for receiving all or any part of the Grand Prize, the winner of the Grand Prize will be required to execute a release, waiver and indemnity in favour of Last Door, its officers, directors, employees and agents, releasing the aforesaid from any and all liability, damages, costs and expenses which may be suffered or incurred by the winner arising from or in any way connected to the prizes awarded and indemnifying the aforesaid in respect of any such claim of any third party.
- 10. TICKETS** - Only 14,250 tickets will be printed. Chances are 1 in 14,250 (total tickets for sale) to win a grand prize; actual odds depend on number of tickets sold.
- 11. DETERMINATION OF PRIZE VALUES** - Any reference as to the value of any prize is the estimated suggested retail replacement cost of such prize as quoted by the suppliers of such prize at the date of the commencement of the Lottery. Entrants should be aware that the fair market value and the actual resale value of any prize may be less than the stated value. The Last Door in no way represents or warrants that any prize winner will be able to obtain equivalent cash value upon resale of any prize. The total fair market value of all the prizes is \$80,000.
- 12. LAWS** - The Lottery is subject to all Federal, Provincial, and Municipal laws and regulations.
- 13. CUTOFF TIMES AND DATES** - **Vendor** sales will be cut off at 12 pm on December 18, Last Door must receive all mailed cheque orders by December 14, 2008. No tickets will be sold over the phone, online or via fax after 9pm December 22, 2009. Ticket sales will cease at Last Door grounds at 12 pm December 22, 2009.
- 14. LIMITATIONS** - In the event of any loss to or destruction of any tickets whether through inadvertent negligence or any cause whatsoever, the liability of Last Door shall be limited to the cost of the ticket provided that no compensation will be made in absence of proof of purchase to the satisfaction of the Last Door.
