Three years ago Peter became the main group Facilitator for Last Door's "Parent Group". This group of parents meets weekly under Peter's guidance to offer support and encouragement to each other; to share success and to encourage each other and each other's children. This group is one of the most successful and cohesive groups within Last Door's Family Program, thanks to Peter's sensitivity and commitment.

Although he is older now and a Father himself, Peter still attracts youth to recovery. Peter has become better with age, a goal we all strive for.
