



Patient Consent for Hospital to Access PharmaNet Information

The Province of British Columbia has established the provincial computerized pharmacy network and database known as "PharmaNet" pursuant to section 37 of the Pharmacists, Pharmacy Operations and Drug Scheduling Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 363.

I, _____ [Name of Patient, please print], authorize access to my personal health information contained within PharmaNet by medical practitioners, pharmacists, and other authorized persons for the purposes of providing therapeutic treatment or care to me in _____ [Name of Hospital] ("the Hospital").

If I have a keyword on my medication profile, I will provide the keyword to enable hospital access to my PharmaNet information as required. When I am no longer receiving care or treatment from the Hospital, the keyword that I have provided will be removed from all hospital records relating to me.

I understand that if I am not able, for any reason, to provide my keyword, and a medical practitioner has reasonable grounds to believe that safe and effective care and treatment cannot be provided without accessing my medication profile, he/she will do so by contacting the PharmaNet HelpDesk to have the keyword removed from my profile.

I understand that this consent will expire when I am no longer receiving care or treatment from the Hospital. If I wish to withdraw this consent prior to that time, the withdrawal must be in writing and delivered to the Hospital.
